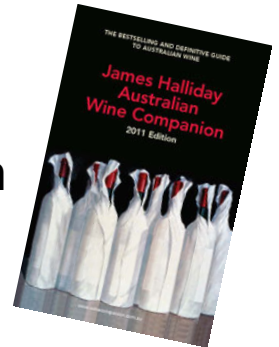

“Over the past 30 years Maxwell Wines has carved out a reputation as a premium producer in McLaren Vale. The brand has produced some excellent red wines in recent years, making the most of the solid limestone hill in the Seaview area on which the winery and vineyards are situated. The majority of the vines on the estate were planted in 1972, and include 19 rows of the highly regarded Reynella Selection cabernet sauvignon. The Ellen Street shiraz block in front of the winery was planted in 1953... Owned and operated by Mark Maxwell.”
